The Residential Clinical Aide/Agency Floater is responsible for assisting the Agate Heights Assisted Living Facility/Boarding Home clinical program to support the overall care of adults with serious and persistent mental illness. This position also provides ancillary support to other LWC programs as needed and includes some evening and weekend hours.

Minimum Qualifications:

At least a High School Diploma plus experience in working with special needs populations; AA or BA in Human Services related discipline preferred; Good organizational skills; Ability to work independently and manage multiple tasks; Ability to work cooperatively in a team approach; Ability to apply a Recovery based approach and to apply clinical knowledge; Good verbal and written communication skills; Basic computer skills; Ability to exercise independent judgment and discretion; Visual and auditory skills required to communicate, to ensure and deliver client care, and to provide legal documentation of care; Requires frequent standing, bending at the knees and waist, kneeling and reaching; Requires frequent walking to accomplish tasks; Requires ability to lift 30 pounds. Ability to obtain Department of Health Agency Affiliated Counselor license within 7 days of hire, Home Care Aide Certification or ability to obtain within 120 days of hire, First Aid/CPR, and successful completion of Boarding Home training requirements (WAC 388-112). Employment is contingent on successful fingerprint background check.
